

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD GUIDELINES

Who can apply?

- Family caregivers, persons with memory loss, support group facilitators, agency/facility staff members and students who do not have the financial resources for the registration fee are eligible for scholarships. Final notification of scholarship awards will be made by April 15, 2010.
- Scholarships will be awarded to no more than **two (2) staff members** from one agency.
- Students will only be considered if they are actively working in the field.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis with family members and persons with memory loss being given priority for scholarship awards. Funding limitations may prevent support to those who had received scholarship support in the past two years.
- Priority will also be given to support group facilitators affiliated with the Alzheimer's Association.

Submission Notes:

- Scholarship awards will only cover conference registration fees. Travel & lodging expenses are not included. Be sure to check off the appropriate box on the request form to let us know your scholarship needs. Full or partial scholarships are available.
- No applications will be accepted after the deadline – **March 22, 2010**. Be sure your application is postmarked no later than March 22, 2010.
- Be sure to include your conference registration form along with your scholarship application.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified in writing no later than April 15, 2010.
- If a scholarship recipient cannot accept the award, they are required to notify the conference planner as soon as possible. This scholarship will be passed on to another applicant.
